

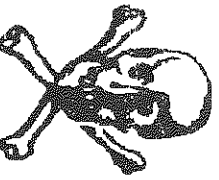

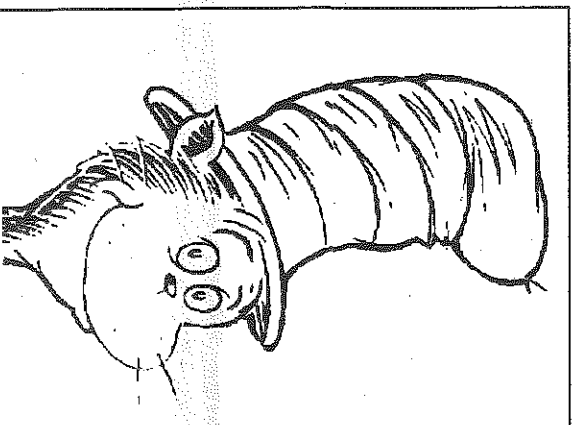

Dome-dweller cancels experiment

"I won't spend two years with Bea Arthur"

ORACLE, Ariz. - One of eight members of a team that is scheduled to spend two years in a self-sustaining glass dome backed out of the deal after finding that another of the team members will be actress Bea Arthur.

"If you think that I'm going to spend two years in a civilization where that woman is one of only eight people in existence, well then, my friend, you're out of your gourd," said A. Tad Mutch.

The search for a replacement has postponed the date the experiment was to begin. The crew was supposed to enter the dome Aug. 26. The crew of eight - four men and four

woman who call themselves biospherians - are to be sealed in a glass-enclosed, self-sustaining mini-world called Biosphere II. The 3.15-acre dome is a re-creation of the environment of earth, which the group calls Biosphere I.

The crew will raise its own food, build its own tools, dispose of its wastes and produce its own music videos. Arthur, who stars on *Golden Girls* and who played *Maude* and other TV characters, had no comment on Mutch's pulling out of the deal.

Mutch said he would still like to participate in the experiment; perhaps at a future time.
